Changes to Itinerary and Water Levels: Please note mooring and casting off times are only guidelines. We reserve the right to make changes to the itineraries and excursion programs. If due to weather, a defective ship, or a section of waterway is closed to travel, the ship-owner reserves the right to transport guests along this section by bus or change the course of that part of the journey. These situations are rare but do happen from time to time and are all part of riverboat vacations. There's nothing anyone can do to control Mother Nature. Please note all rivers and oceans that you will travel on have shipping channels that are maintained by national nautical authorities. On rare occasions, travel may be impacted by weather or water levels in these shipping channels. Usually, minor adjustments in the ships cruise schedule will allow safe and unimpeded passage – even under challenging circumstances. Precipitation patterns are relatively even throughout the year which makes long-term predicting of high or low water impossible. Luckily, major disruptions are rare exceptions, and most cruises take place exactly as planned.
